The **Caux Arts and Peace Encounters** is organized by the Caux Initiatives of Change Foundation. Caux Initiatives of Change is also the hosting entity and therefore the main contact and body responsible for legal and organizational issues.

These **General Terms and Conditions** are valid for all attendees including sponsored participants and volunteers of the Caux Arts and Peace Encounters from the 12 – 14 May 2025

Registration

For organizational reasons, **registration prior to the event is mandatory** for every person who wants to take part in the Caux Arts and Peace Encounters.

Registrations will close on the **23 April 2025**, subject to change by the organizers. Please note that if registrations reach the maximum capacity for the event before this date, the organizers may suspend registrations prior to this closing date.

All attendees must register via the online registration form that they will receive by email or via the website.

Registration Procedure

1. The registration form allows you to register yourself and any accompanying persons. All participants must pre-pay the full registration fees to complete the registration process and confirm participation.
Payment can be made securely by credit card using PayPal.
Bank transfer is also an option on request. Payment for bookings with multiple participants must be completed in a single transaction. For those opting for bank transfer, the reservation will be held for 10 days until payment is received. A processing fee of CHF 30 applies to cover bank and exchange charges.
2. Upon confirmation of payment, you'll receive your official confirmation along with all necessary information to plan your stay in Caux.
3. Individual exceptions for payment methods may be considered on a case-by-case basis upon request. Please contact us at reservation@caux.ch for related inquiries.

Caux Arts and Peace Encounters - General Information on Package Fees

As indicated on our registration form, registration covers the duration of the full Caux Arts and Peace Encounters **from 12-14 May 2025**.

The package price is fixed for the entire duration of the event, and therefore non-adjustable according to meals taken or not. The first meal served and included is dinner on Monday evening, 12 May, and the last meal served and included is lunch on the final day, Wednesday 14 May.

The tourist tax will entitle you to receive the **Montreux Riviera Card**, which provides discounts on certain activities around Caux as well as on transport. Please note that the card will be **given to you at the time of check-in at the Caux Palace** and not before your arrival. Arrival and departure information

Check-in is from 14:00 on 14 May 2025.

On the day of departure, the programme will end at 16:00. For organizational reasons and to prepare our spaces for other event, we will kindly request all participants to check out by 10:00 on the day of departure and to leave the site by 17:00.

Package Fees – With accommodation at the Caux Palace

Prices mentioned are for shared accommodation and include:

- Accommodation in a shared room either at the Caux Palace or the Villa Maria.
- Participation in the Caux Arts and Peace Encounters Programme
- Materials provided during the event
- Coffee and tea breaks as well as refreshments
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner
- VAT & City taxes

All rooms are equipped with a private bathroom with shower/bath and WC. Most of them have a balcony with panoramic views.

Please be aware that our bedrooms are not equipped with TV, minibar, hairdryer, or kettle.

Payment Methods

As mentioned above, we require participants to fully pre-pay their registrations in advance of the event. Reservations paid by credit card are directly and automatically confirmed upon receipt of payment. You will receive confirmation by email with full practical information.

Reservations paid by bank transfer will be confirmed upon receipt of the transfer required within 10 days after receiving the registration confirmation with payment instructions.

For payment by bank transfer, a payment fee of CHF 30 will be charged to cover admin costs, exchange rates and bank charges. All payments prior to your arrival should be made in Swiss Francs (CHF).

Cancellation Policy

Since cancellations have a considerable impact on the organization of the event, it is vital to inform the Reservations Team of any cancellation as early as possible by email: Reservation@caux.ch

In the event of individual or group cancellations, the following cancellation policy applies:

- **Reservations canceled before 12 April, 2025, will be eligible for a refund.**

Caux Initiatives of Change will reimburse the amount paid, minus any bank fees and transfer costs incurred during the payment process. Please note that Caux Initiatives of Change cannot be held responsible for any foreign exchange losses incurred during this process.

- **Reservations canceled after 12 April, 2025, will not be refunded.**

A 100% reservation fee will be charged for late cancellations. Refunds may be considered under certain circumstances (as for visa refusals), and requests for reimbursement should be directed to our email address: Reservation@caux.ch. No refunds will be issued for no-shows.

- **Refunds for Visa Refusals**

Refunds may be considered in the event of a visa refusal. To request a refund under these circumstances, the applicant must provide official proof of the visa denial when contacting the Reservations Team at Reservation@caux.ch.

Visa Requirements

Prospective attendees who require an entry visa for Switzerland must **allow sufficient time for the visa application procedure**. They should contact the nearest Swiss embassy or consulate before planning their trip to learn about the requirements and visa type needed.

We will provide an invitation and stay confirmation letter to participants who have provided the correct information on our form and completely paid the registration fees. This letter is often required for visa procedures but does not guarantee that your application will be accepted.

The visa application is the sole responsibility of the participant. As a visa request can only be submitted three months before traveling and can take up to eight weeks to process, **we strongly recommend that you apply as early as possible** and carefully study the visa requirements with

the relevant embassy or consulate. Missing documents can be a ground for visa refusal. Please visit <https://www.eda.admin.ch/eda/en/home.html> for more information on the visa application procedure.

Caux Initiatives of Change reserves the right to refuse applications of people who need a visa and who are unable to provide the necessary references and documents requested on our form in order to prevent the misuse of the visa invitation and confirmation of stay letter.

Data Protection and Use of Contact Details

Upon registration and by accepting these Terms and Conditions, you authorize Caux Initiatives of Change, registered as CAUX – Initiatives of Change, to use your personal data as stated in the registration form to contact you in relation to the registration process, the event and your stay, as well as for communications purposes related to the event including, but not limited to: sending event updates (event logistics, schedule and speakers), promotional materials related to the event or similar future events, and seeking feedback and conducting surveys related to the event.

The data will also be used to inform the organizing team of the conference or programme about their attendees. It may also be used for statistical analyses but in that case will be anonymized.

All data will be treated confidentially and will not be sold or transferred to any third parties outside the organizing bodies.

Unless indicated otherwise by you via the registration form, the Caux Initiatives of Change Foundation may use your contact details after the event, to send you an event report and related information, and to inform you about upcoming events. You will be able to opt out of receiving such email communications.

Should an attendee not abide by our Terms and Conditions or show any form of disrespect, Caux Initiatives of Change reserves the right to expel that attendee and set an unlimited duration to that decision. This right is exercised at the discretion of the Caux Initiatives of Change Executive Director.

Special colored lanyards are issued to those people not wishing to have images of themselves published. Attendees may take and share their own photographs for private use as long as the attendees comply with some basic rules of respect towards the subjects photographed.

The Caux Arts and Peace Encounters offers a safe space that needs to be respected. Participants should not take photographs in such a way as to hide from the subject that they are being photographed. If the subject does not agree to be photographed, their will must be respected. Photography/recording should be treated like other potentially harassing interpersonal interactions. When one person in the interaction says 'stop' or 'leave me alone' or words to that effect, the interaction must end. In such cases, attendees should not attempt to photograph that individual again.

Lastly, the subject may inspect the photo/recording at any time and, if requested, the photograph or footage must be immediately deleted.

The Communications Team will not share all of its photographs with individual attendees.
