USEFUL INFORMATION FOR YOUR STAY

WELCOME MESSAGE

It is our great pleasure to be soon welcoming you to the Caux Palace. For your journey to Caux we have prepared some useful information. Please carefully read through this information as it will be very helpful for preparing your stay and planning your arrival.

IMPORTANT TO KNOW ABOUT CAUX

Caux is situated at 1050M above sea level and it can get quickly chilly. Please inform yourselves about the needed luggage depending on the season when you are travelling to Caux. Please note that there are no shops and no restaurants available in Caux and that you will need to go down the mountain to Glion or Montreux by train. **Don't forget your own medicine if needed, we are not able to hand out any to you.**

HOW TO REACH THE CAUX PALACE

The easiest way to get to Caux is by train. The train station in Caux is only 50 meters away from the Caux Palace. Please visit www.sbb.ch for train timetables. Taxis are always available in front of the train station in Montreux. Moreover we inform you that the Uber application also works from Montreux to Caux.

If you are travelling by car (or taxi) from Lausanne/Vevey : think to adjust your GPS route passing by « Clarens » or « Montreux Gare », but do not take the automatic recommendation passing by « Les Avants » (this will take you through a longer curvy mountain road and the ride is much longer and complicated).

WHEN ARRIVING AT THE CAUX PALACE SITE

Our team is informed of your estimated time of arrival at the Caux train station or at our parking area. A member of our team will be present at the entrance of the building to welcome you and show you around the building as well as the spaces for your dedicated meetings and common areas.

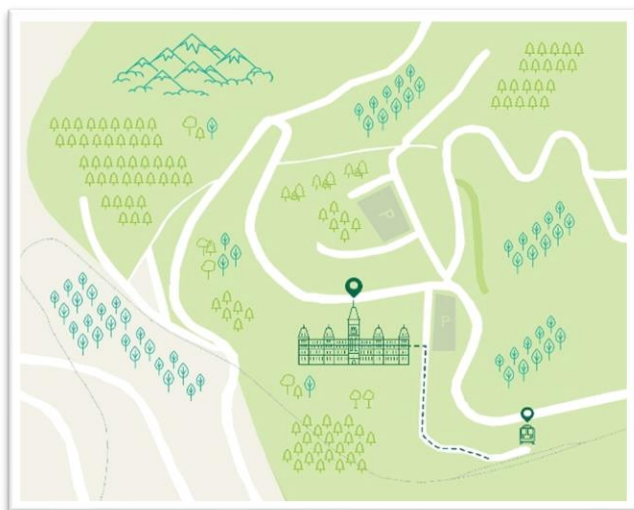


ENTERING THE BUILDING

The doors of the Caux Palace remain closed at all times. You can enter the building via the door next to the main entrance or via the 2nd floor side-entrance with your key card. If you have any problem to enter the building, please contact our team at **+41 21 962 91 11**

PARKING

There are two designated parking lots by the Caux Palace as you can see in the illustration below. **All the parking spaces are free of charge.** There are other parking lots available in the closer area but we recommend that you use our spaces first according to availability.



CAUX PALACE

Our bedrooms are all located in the Caux Palace and have a balcony with a stunning view over the Alps and Lake Lemman or direct access to the Garden. All of our rooms in the Caux Palace are equipped with shower/bath, WC, telephone and free Wi-Fi-internet access. Please note that our bedrooms are not equipped with TV, Minibar, Hairdryer or Kettle. Moreover our rooms are not equipped with large beds but only with single beds and for the rooms in twin occupancy, of separate beds, that we can bring together.

Smoking is prohibited inside the building and on balconies.



RECEPTION DESK

Please be aware that our foundation staff does not have a dedicated reception area. However, we are always available to assist you.
